You will need this to register as an Intern Architect with the OAA or any other provincial or territorial architecture body in Canada.

Don't have it yet? Check with your school's registrar or administration if they have sent the information to the CACB.

Already have it? Then you can go ahead and register as an Intern Architect! You don't need to be employed or have chosen your mentor yet to apply.
