

BY-LAW NO 1.

under the *Architects Act, 1990, c. A.26*;

A by-law relating to the administration and domestic affairs of the Ontario Association of Architects (hereinafter called the "Association").

BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Ontario Association of Architects.

Schedule 'A' is amended as follows:

- 1) The annual fee for a Student Associate is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

Student AssociateNo Charge

- 2) Under the annual fee for a Certificate of Practice the following section is deleted:

On filing of application\$ 250.00
Annual Fees – based on the number of Licensed Architects and Licensed Technologists OAA in the practice
- practice with one Licensed Architect\$ 412.00
- fee for each additional Licensed Architect within the practice add.....\$ 309.00

The above section is replaced with the following:

On filing of application\$ 250.00
Annual Fees – based on the number of Licensed Architects and Licensed Technologists OAA in the practice
- practice with one Licensed Architect\$ 412.00
- fee for each additional Licensed Architect within the practice add.....\$ 309.00
- fee for each additional Licensed Technologist OAA within the practice add.....\$ 206.00

- 3) The reference to 'Certificate of Practice Issued Under Section 23 of the Act' is deleted and the following substituted therefor

Temporary Certificate of Practice Issued Under the *Architects Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. A. 26, s. 23*

- 4) The fee for the application to attend the Admission Course is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

On application to attend the Admission Course.....\$ 350.00

- 5) The section titled 'Canadian Experience Record Book – Late Submission and Retroactive Entry Charges' is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

Canadian Experience Record Book – Late Submission Charges

The following Late Submission Charges apply to experience records which are not submitted within eight weeks of the date of the last entry:

\$100 for every 1000 hours or portion thereof.

- 6) That under Financial Hardship reference to the Canadian Handbook of Practice is deleted and the paragraph set out as follows:

The fees set out in this by-law may be waived, reduced or deferred in whole or in part by the Executive Director in accordance with the terms of the Association's Financial Hardship policy.
