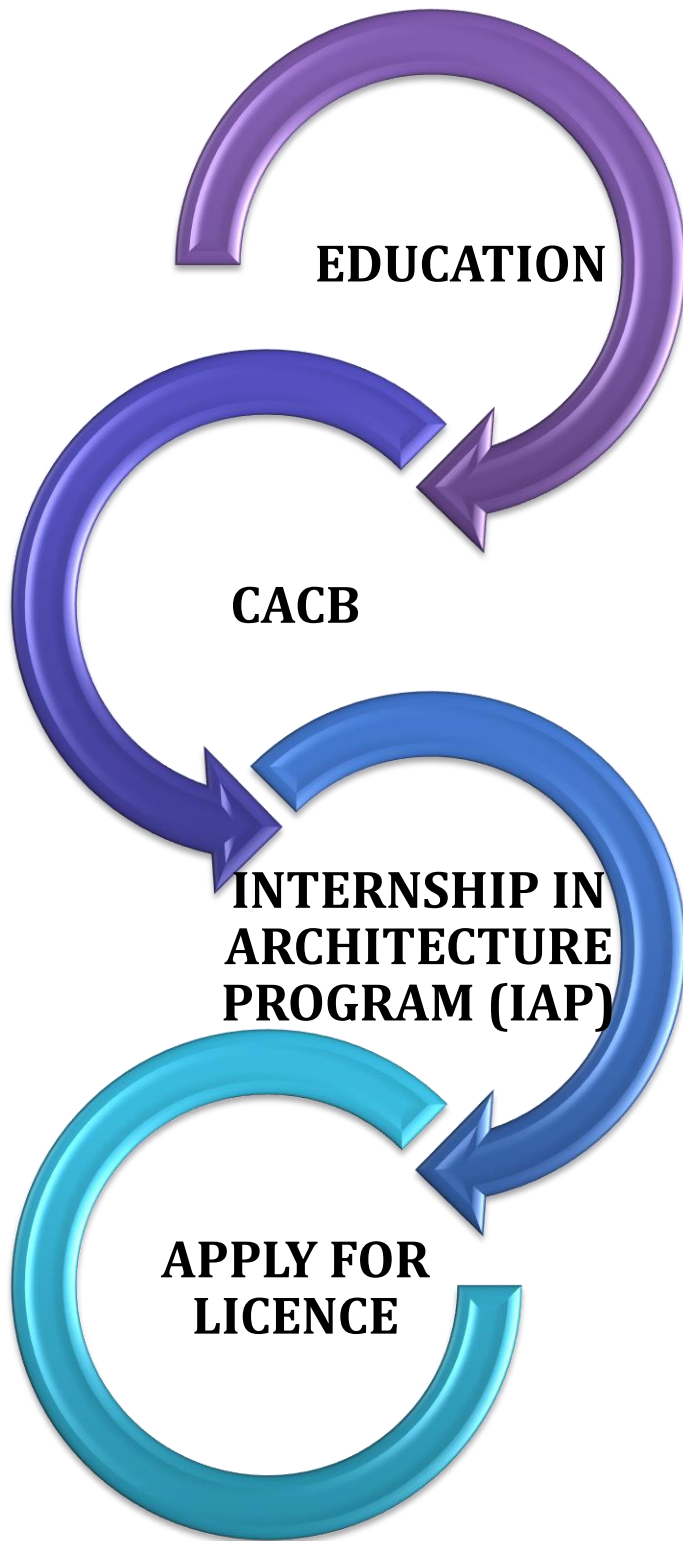

EDUCATION

- **A Pre-Professional Degree in Architecture** (e.g. BAS, BES, B. Sc.(Arch), BArch. Sci) followed by a **Professional Degree in Architecture** (e.g. M.Arch) from an accredited school of architecture in Canada/USA OR
- **RAIC Syllabus Program**

CACB

- *Academic qualifications must be certified by the Canadian Architectural Certification Board (CACB)*

INTERNSHIP IN ARCHITECTURE PROGRAM (IAP)

- **Experience Requirements**
Completion of 3720 hours of architectural experience
NOTE: Currency requirement of 940 hours of experience in Ontario

- **Examination Requirements**
The Examination for Architects in Canada (ExAC) or The Architect Registration Examination (ARE)

- **OAA Admission Course**
Covers content relevant to the practice of architecture such as legislation, regulations, and professional business environment
